Easter Message 2024

For those who require proof, none will suffice. For those who do not require proof, none is necessary. In essence this is what faith is, belief in that which we cannot perceive with our sensory organs. St. Paul tells us, if we do not believe that Jesus has risen from the dead, then our faith is in vain.

We are Easter people, the people of the resurrection. Our faith is founded on Jesus Christ who has been raised to heavenly glory by the God he called his Father and who invites us to call this same God, our Father. The Easter season brings us joy and gives us hope. The same hope and joy experienced by the first disciples whose lives were plunged into despair after the death of their beloved leader, the one that they believed to be the Messiah that they hoped for.

This is the great Christian message hope.

Hope in a better future, hope in a better world. The resurrection, for we who believe, gives us hope in a life after death, joy after sorrow and forgiveness after guilt. We are the recipients of the mercy and


