GOSPEL REFLECTION

Regardless of its original intended purpose, this passage of the Gospel provides a wonderful account of the appearance of the resurrected Jesus to his disciples. Like other post-resurrection accounts, the disciples do not at first recognise Jesus and it is not until the miraculous catch of fish that the beloved disciple declares, 'It is the Lord'. In a beautifully everyday touch, the risen Jesus prepares breakfast on the beach for the disciples and blesses the simple food in the same way as he did the bread and wine at their last supper.

We make a living by what we get... we make a life by what we give.

We are about to embark on a Sacrificial Offering Campaign (starting in June).

Campaigns such as this are as old as the church itself. The first recorded sacrificial offering campaign is found in the time of St Paul. Writing to the newly converted Christians of Achaia, he reminded them: Those who sow sparingly will reap sparingly, and those who sow bountifully, will reap bountifully. Everyone must give according to what they have decided in their heart; not with sadness, or grudgingly, for God loves a cheerful giver. And God can bless you in every way, so that you may always have enough of everything with a surplus for every good work; as it is written "Lavishly he gave to the poor, his generosity endures forever."

What is a Sacrificial Offering? A sacrificial offering is something given or done as a sacrifice. It is the act of a grateful person, freely giving back part of what their God-given talents have enabled them to gain, achieve and obtain. When you offer a part of the "fruits of your work", you offer yourself to God – that is what "sacrifice" means.

We ask you to think about and seriously consider "My pledge to offer... What shall it be? How can I help build, develop and grow our Parish?"

Gospel Focus – Do you love me? Three times Jesus asks Peter, 'Do you love me?' and three times Peter answers, 'You know I do'. Some writers suggest that the three-fold question by Jesus and the three-fold reply by Peter is intended to balance out the triple denial of Jesus by Peter at the time of the arrest and trial of Jesus. Where once Peter denied even knowing Jesus, he now declares his love for Jesus in no uncertain terms. It is a reminder to all of us that there is no act that we can perform that cannot be forgiven by God and from which we cannot come back.
