THURSDAY 25 APRIL, 2024 ANZAC DAY

This day marks the landing of Australian and New Zealand soldiers at Gallipoli during the Great War of 1914-1918. It has become a national day of remembrance in which we honour the courage and self-sacrifice of those who have served in all wars, conflicts, and peacekeeping operations. The liturgy recognises the sacrifice of the fallen, commends them to eternal life, and prays that the justice and peace which they sought to defend may dwell in our lands.

ENTRANCE VERSE: Blessed are the dead who lie in the Lord. Let them rest from their labours, for their good deeds go with them.

First Reading: Wisdom 3: 1-9

PSALM RESPONSE:

I will walk in the presence of the Lord in the land of the living.

GOSPEL ACCLAMATION:

Alleluia, alleluia!

Happy are those who have died in the Lord; let them rest from their labours for their good deeds go with them.

Alleluia!

The Gospel: John 12: 23-28

COMMUNION VERSE:

Greater love has no one than to lay down his life for his friends, says the Lord.

FRIDAY 26 APRIL, 2024 ST MARK

ENTRANCE VERSE: Go into all the world, and proclaim the Gospel to every creature, alleluia.

First Reading: 1 Peter 5:5-14

PSALM RESPONSE: For ever I will sing the goodness of the Lord.

GOSPEL ACCLAMATION: Alleluia, alleluia! We preach a Christ who was crucified; he is the power and the wisdom of God. Alleluia!

The Gospel: Mark 16: 15-20

<u>COMMUNION VERSE:</u> Behold, I am with you always, even to the end of the age, says the Lord, alleluia.

SATURDAY 27 APRIL, 2024 SATURDAY OF THE 4TH WEEK OF EASTER

ENTRANCE VERSE: O chosen people, proclaim the mighty works of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light, alleluia!

First Reading: Acts 13:44-52

<u>PSALM RESPONSE</u>: All the ends of the earth have seen the saving power of God.

GOSPEL ACCLAMATION: Alleluia, alleluia! If you stay in my word, you will indeed be my disciples, and you will know the truth, says the Lord. Alleluia!

The Gospel: John 14:7-14

<u>COMMUNION VERSE</u>: Father, I wish that, where I am, those you gave me may also be with me, that they may see the glory that you gave me, alleluia.
