SAINTS JEROME AND JUDE

Simon “the less” is also called “the Canaanite” and “the Zealot”. Jude (son) of James was traditionally thought to be the same person as Jude, brother of James and author of the letters of Jude but might also be the one called Thaddeus. A tradition has Simon and Jude preaching and being martyred in Persia. Honoured among the twelve apostles, the first followers of Christ.

ENTRANCE VERSE These are the holy men whom the Lord chose in his own perfect love; to them he gave eternal glory.

First Reading: ***Ephesians 2:19-22***

PSALM RESPONSE: Their message goes out though all the earth.

GOSPEL ACCLAMATION: Alleluia, alleluia! You are God; we praise you; you are the Lord: we acclaim you; the glorious company of apostles praise you. Alleluia!

The Gospel: ***Luke 6:12-19***

SATURDAY 1 NOVEMBER 2025
ALL SAINTS

This feast began in the East to commemorate all martyrs and was progressively adopted in the west. Celebrated on this day in the eighth century and soon widely observed. Honoured today are all holy men and women in glory with Christ; known or unknown, mighty or lowly, all whose lives were modelled on the Beatitudes and on the great commandment of love.

ENTRANCE VERSE:

First Reading: ***Revelations 7: 2-4, 9-14***

PSALM RESPONSE: Lord, this is the people that longs to see your face.

GOSPEL ACCLAMATION:

Alleluia, alleluia! Come to me, all you that labour and are burdened, and I will give you rest, says the Lord. Alleluia!

The Gospel: ***Matthew 5: 1-12***

COMMUNION VERSE: Blessed are the clean of heart, for they shall see God. Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called children of God. Blessed are they who are persecuted for the sake of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of Heaven.
