### TUESDAY 4 NOVEMBER 2025 SAINT CHARLES BORROMEO

Born in Arona (Italy) in 1538. Died on this day in 1584 in Milan. Only Twenty-Two when he was appointed Cardinal, secretary of state, and given the administration of the diocese of Milan by his uncle, Pius IV. Prominent in the final session of the Council of Trent during 1562-1563 and, at its end, was ordained presbyter, then bishop and became Archbishop of Milan. Known for implementing the Council's reforms in liturgy, education, presbyteral formation, and diocese organisation. Remembered as an exemplary and pastoral bishop and an ardent proponent of reform and renewal
