SATURDAY 13 SEPTEMBER 2025 SAINT JOHN CHRYSOSTOM

Born in Antioch about 347. Died in exile in Comana (Turkey) on 14 Sept 407. After some years as a hermit, he was a priest at Antioch, where his brilliant preaching and catechesis earned him the sobriquet 'Chrysostom' (golden mouthed). Appointed patriarch of Constantinople in 397. His reforms, preaching and ascetic life led to opposition from court and clergy and eventual banishment. Remembered for his simplicity of life, his care of the poor, the courage of his witness, and his effective preaching of the Scriptures.

ENTRANCE VERSE: Those who are wise will shine brightly like the splendour of the firmament and those who lead the many to justice shall be like the stars forever.
