THURSDAY 5 FEBRUARY 2026

SAINT AGATHA

Died in Sicily, during the persecutions of the third century. Venerated in Rome as a virgin martyr on this day since the sixth century and included by name in Eucharistic Prayer 1 (The Roman Canon). Remembered in legend for her faith and for remaining resolute under torture

ENTRANCE VERSE

Behold, now she follows the Lamb who was crucified for us,
powerful in virginity, modesty her offering, a sacrifice on the
altar of chastity

First Reading: ***1 Kings 2: 1-4, 10-12***

PSALM RESPONSE:

Lord you are exalted over all.

GOSPEL ACCLAMATION:

Alleluia, alleluia!

The kingdom of God is near:

Believe in the Good News!

Alleluia!

The Gospel: ***Mark 6: 7-13***

COMMUNION VERSE:

The Lamb who is at the centre of the throne will lead them to the
springs of the waters of life.

FRIDAY 6 FEBRUARY 2026
SAINT PAUL MIKI & COMPANIONS

The Gospel: *Mark 6: 14-29*

COMMUNION VERSE: It is you who have stood by me in my trials; and I confer a kingdom on you, says the Lord, that you may eat and drink at my table in my kingdom.
