**PSALM RESPONSE:** *Praise the Lord, Jerusalem*

**GOSPEL ACCLAMATION:** Alleluia, alleluia! Jesus preached the Good News of the kingdom and healed all who were sick. Alleluia!

***The Gospel:*** *Luke 5: 12-16*

**COMMUNION VERSE:** By this the love of God was revealed to us: God sent his Only Begotten Son into the world, so that we might have life through him.

**SATURDAY 10 JANUARY 2026**  
**SATURDAY AFTER THE EPIPHANY**

**ENTRANCE VERSE:** God sent his Son, born of a woman, so that we might receive adoption as children.

***First Reading:*** *1 John 5: 14-21*

**PSALM RESPONSE:** The Lord takes delight in his people

**GOSPEL ACCLAMATION:** Alleluia, alleluia! A people in darkness have seen a great light; a radiant dawn shines on those lost in death. Alleluia!

***The Gospel:*** *John 3: 22-30*

**COMMUNION VERSE:** From his fullness we have all received, grace upon grace.
