**THURSDAY 11 JUNE 2026**  
**SAINT BARNABAS**

*It is not known when he died, but according to Eastern and Western tradition his remains were discovered on this day sometime in the fifth century. A Jew from Cyprus and one of the first converts in Jerusalem, a leading member of the Church there, though not one of the twelve. He introduced St Paul to the twelve and worked with him in Antioch and on missionary work in the Mediterranean world. Championed the Gentiles at the Council of Jerusalem. Remembered as a good man, full of the Holy Spirit and of faith (Acts 11: 21)*

**ENTRANCE VERSE**

Blessed is this holy man, who was worthy to be numbered among the Apostles, for he was a good man, filled with the Holy Spirit and with faith.

**GOSPEL ACCLAMATION:**

Alleluia, alleluia! Go and teach all people my gospel. I am with you always until the end of the world. Alleluia!

**COMMUNION VERSE:**

I no longer call you slaves, because a slave does not know what his master is doing. But I have called you friends, because I have told you everything I have heard from my Father.

**FRIDAY 12 JUNE 2026**

**THE MOST SACRED HEART OF JESUS**

*This devotion which dates from the Middle Ages and flowered in France in the seventeenth century because of the visions of St. Margaret Mary Alacoque (16 October). The feast was extended to the entire Western Church by Pius IX in 1856. It recalls the mystery of God who is love and honours the heart of Jesus as the source and centre of the incarnate love of God.*

**ENTRANCE VERSE:** The designs of his heart are from age to age, to rescue their souls from death, and to keep them alive in famine.

***First Reading:*** *Deuteronomy 7:6-11*

**PSALM RESPONSE:** The Lord's kindness is everlasting to those who fear him.

**GOSPEL ACCLAMATION:** Alleluia, alleluia! Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and lowly of heart. Alleluia!

***The Gospel:*** *Matthew 11:25-30*

**COMMUNION VERSE:** Thus says the Lord: Let whoever is thirsty come to me and drink. Streams of living water will flow from within the one who believes in me.
