WEDNESDAY 15 JULY 2026
SAINT BONAVENTURE

Born at Bagnoregio (Italy) about 1218. Died at Lyons (France) on this day in 1274. He joined the Franciscans when studying in Paris and eventually became minister general of the order. Later appointed cardinal-bishop of Lyons. Known as the “Seraphic Doctor” Remembered as a teacher, for his extensive biblical and mystical writings, and for his holiness, gentleness, and compassion.
