SAINT MATTHIAS

A companion of Jesus and a witness to the resurrection. Chosen by lot to take the place of Judas and so to share the apostolic ministry of the twelve (Acts 1: 15-26). He is named in the Eucharistic Prayer 1 (The Roman Canon)

ENTRANCE VERSE

It was not you who chose me, says the Lord, but I who chose you and appointed you to go and bear fruit, fruit that will last, alleluia.

First Reading: ***Acts 1: 15-17, 20-26***

PSALM RESPONSE:

The Lord will give him a seat with the leaders of his people.

GOSPEL ACCLAMATION:

Alleluia, alleluia!

Live in me and let me live in you, says the Lord; my branches bear much fruit.

Alleluia!

The Gospel: ***John 15: 9-17***

COMMUNION VERSE:

This is my commandment: Love one another as I have loved you, says the Lord, alleluia!
