#### **Reflection Leo's Lens**

'A Church that sets no limits to love, that knows no enemies to fight but only men and women to love, is the Church that the world needs today', says Pope Leo. The Pope is very concerned to bring us back to the essentials of our Faith. He speaks of 'caring for the poor', for instance, as 'a beacon as it were of evangelical light.' Similarly, he speaks of how 'love for the poor – whatever the form their poverty may take – is the evangelical hallmark of a Church faithful to the heart of God.' In short, the Pope is reminding us that we proclaim Christ most effectively when we are Christ-like in our attitudes and actions towards others. This is most especially true when we are dealing with those in need or otherwise on the margins of society.

'The dominant culture', the Pope suggests, 'would have us abandon the poor to their fate and consider them unworthy of attention, much less our respect.' But, through our faith we see them differently. In the poor, we see the suffering of Our Lord himself. This is a message worth proclaiming to the world.

'For Christians,' the Pope affirms, 'the poor are not a sociological category, but the very "flesh" of Christ.' In that sense, we are always challenged to prepare for our Lord by being open to encountering him anywhere there is need.
