A CHRISTMAS MESSAGE (from Fr Jim)

"Christmas comes but once a year, and when it comes it brings good cheer."

This is the rhyme most people know,

and we hope that the sentiment will be fulfilled.

For many of us, this year has been a year filled with joy and sorrow, tragedy and grief. No more so than the appalling shooting atrocity which occurred at Bondi Beach on Sunday, 14th December during festivities celebrating the Jewish feast of Hanukkah.

The feast of Hanukkah, which coincides with our Christmas feast of the Incarnation, celebrates the rededication of the Temple in Jerusalem by the Jewish "freedom fighters", the Maccabees, who liberated the Temple and the city from their pagan oppressors.

As people of the "New Covenant", we stand in solidarity with our Jewish brothers and sisters, the people of the "Old Covenant". We hold them up in prayer to the God who has never abandoned them and to the God who loves us all.

For those of us who have lost a beloved member of our family, I hope that this Christmas will fill you with the peace which the Christ child brings.

I pray that you may find solace from your pain and grief and that the message of Jesus, the "Prince of Peace", will bring you healing and comfort.


CHILDREN'S LITURGY [CLOW] - SESSIONS HAVE FINISHED FOR 2025.
