ST MARY'S PARISH RCIA UPDATE

(from Kevin Mark)

Our parish RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) has been underway for several weeks. This Sunday (Dec 7th) marks the next stage in the RCIA journey for those seeking to join the Catholic Church at St Mary's Parish. At the 11.00 am Mass, the Rite of Acceptance into the Order of Catechumens will be celebrated for those who are unbaptised.

The Rite of Welcome will also be celebrated for those already baptised and preparing to be received into the Catholic Church ("Candidates").

From this Sunday Mass and until their full initiation into the Catholic Church next Easter, both Catechumens and Candidates are "dismissed" at the end of the Liturgy of the Word. The RCIA group and team leave the body of the Basilica to continue considering the significance of the Scripture readings for their faith journey as an essential aspect of their RCIA journey.
